I'm thrilled to acknowledge this generous level of support in this year's annual report. Donors are included in the following pages along with details about how your gifts made an impact.





# Fund to Support Student Mental Health Became a Lifeline for Families in Crisis

Community Generosity Fills Urgent Need in Response to Covid-19 Shutdown

As school closings were announced in Pennsylvania to combat the spread of COVID-19, Director of Student Services Jeanne Knouse and her team quickly saw a new need taking shape in the SCASD community: major financial hardship among many families in the district. Facing layoffs, job loss, and the closing or scaling back of their businesses, families were struggling to afford the most basic necessities—food, utility payments, transportation costs and other unique needs.

In partnership with the Education Foundation, the district announced that the Mental Health Matters Fund—established last year to support student mental health initiatives—was immediately open for contributions to help

WE GOVE THANK TORE cover these emergency needs. In just over a month, more than \$100,000 was raised—and much of it distributed—to help families.

This incredible display of generosity has changed lives not only by filling basic needs, but also by showing that during uncertain times, our families can rely on one another for help.

The student services staff anticipates a significant increase in the need for mental health services in 2020-21 and the district could face major budget strains in the coming years. In response, the Education Foundation has determined that all funds contributed through the end of its fiscal year on June 30, 2020, will be unrestricted and prioritized for these areas: emergency funds for families, mental health services, and emerging priorities identified by the district.

# In Loving Memory: The Mardi Lowry McDonough '87 Student Opportunity Fund & Grant Program

The State College community lost a wonderful teacher and a dear friend who made a difference in the lives of countless students and her fellow educators. Mardi Lowry McDonough '87 passed away June 1 following a battle with breast cancer. In partnership with her family, the Education Foundation is honoring her memory.

A lifelong resident of State College, Mardi graduated from State High in 1987. She spent her 27 years in the State College Area School District teaching 6th grade Math, English, and Science, starting at Ferguson Township Elementary and then at Park Forest Middle School. Mardi's daughters are also State High graduates.

"In recognition of her own experience, the experiences of her daughters Colleen and Grace, her exemplary career as a teacher, and her honorable service to teachers and the community, the Education Foundation board is privileged to name this fund and program in Mardi's honor," said Board President Chris Buchignani. "We are delighted that we are able to work with her family on this opportunity to continue to impact our students, teachers, and the entire State College community through this fund and grant program."

Mardi's family will attend an annual gathering with grant winners to celebrate their initiative and achievements. Also, in recognition of Mardi's membership in the High School Concert and Marching Bands and her love of music, the Education Foundation plans to award at least one grant each cycle to a music department, music program, or music group-related request.

Mardi is survived by her husband, Nick Downs, and two daughters, Colleen Eireann McDonough and Grace Aine McDonough, all of State College; step-daughter, Sierra Downs of Boston, MA; father, Lee Lowry of State College and mother, Carol Spangler of Huntingdon, PA. Also survived by her brother, Eric Lowry (Dr. Marta Villaraga) and nieces, Sofia and Isabela of Ardmore, PA.

# Renewed Support from EITC Donors Keeps Programs Growing

When the Education Foundation was launched, a main priority was securing funds through the Education Improvement Tax Credit program. This state-operated program, known as EITC, dedicates tax credits to individuals and businesses who make contributions to qualifying 501(c)3 organizations.

While the program is most often associated with providing scholarships to low-income families for private school tuition, a portion of EITC funds are dedicated to Education Improvement Organizations or EIOs—organizations working to provide innovative programming to students. The Education Foundation qualifies for the program as an EIO, and offers a way for individuals and businesses to keep their state tax dollars in local public schools.

The foundation continues to steward individuals and businesses to support its existing EITC-funded programs:

 Materials and equipment needed for new K-5 STEM curriculum, which is based on the resource Engineering is Elementary, the premier resource for introducing engineering at the elementary level. In addition to drawing from EiE, the district is developing learning experiences that include robotics and coding, along with alignment to grade level science and mathematics.  Computer programming courses at the high school level offered through Oracle Academy, a globally-focused computer science education curriculum that gives students access to courses and resources that would not have been possible without the partnership.

Both individuals and businesses can apply to donate through EITC, as long as they have PA tax liability and meet a few criteria, but currently the tax credits available for Education Improvement Organizations are fully subscribed, and no additional credits have been approved.

It's important to note that existing donors can renew their support, and that credits do become available when donors drop out of the program. While you may be placed on a waiting list, it's still worthwhile to apply.


